DRIVEWAY PERMITS 4-14-05-23

The Board held a discussion on updating the driveway permits. No driveway may be constructed within the Township of Siren without the issuance of a permit by the Town. They must complete an application signed by the property owner where the driveway is intended to be constructed.

If a driveway is constructed before obtaining a permit both the contractor installing the driveway and the property owner shall pay a forfeiture/fine set by the Town of Siren. If the property owner acts as the contractor in the construction of the driveway, they will be assessed both forfeiture/fines.

ORDINANCE

DRIVEWAY PERMIT

Driveway permits are required in the Township of Siren. This is to ensure proper placement and size requirements. If a driveway is installed without a permit there is a fine of \$500.00 to the company/person installing and a \$500.00 fine to the property owner. This was placed in all tax statements.

RIGHT OF WAY CLEARING

A letter was also placed in the tax statements about the right of way. The township will be clearing brush and trees that have overgrown and are extending into the roadway.

ROADS:
