The Siren Sanitary District held a special board meeting on Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at 5:00PM.

Discussion and action on pressure testing the new sanitary line connecting the Burnett County Government Center: With input from MSA it was concluded the best course of action for the Sanitary District would be to have the line from the round-about to the Gov't Center pressure tested to avoid any future questions (and possible liability) on its ability to handle the waste. A-1 Excavating of Bloomer, WI offered an estimate of \$5000 for two men and a truck for a day to pressure test the line. Motion by Wayne Wiberg to hire A-1 Excavating to test the line. Seconded by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried. MSA will schedule with A-1 for a day the week of November 27<sup>th</sup>.

Motion by Philip Stiemann to adjourn. Seconded by Diane Lund. Motion carried.
