The Town of Siren held a Special Town Meeting of the Electors immediately following the public budget hearing. Attendees; Wayne Wiberg, Philip Stiemann, Diane Lund, Valerie Lindquist, Chris Tewalt.

Chairman Wiberg called the meeting to order at 7:01pm.

Open meeting notices were verified.

Motion by Philip Stiemann to adopt Resolution 2024-10-01 to adopt the 2024 Tax Levy in the amount of \$864,488 to be placed on the tax roll payable in 2025. Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 5-0.

Other Business:

- Motion by Philip Stiemann to increase board salaries to the following effective April, 2025; Chairman \$8,000/year (\$1,000 increase), Supervisors \$5,000/year (\$600 increase), Treasurer \$8,600/year (\$600 increase) and Clerk \$17,000/year (\$1,000 increase). Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 5-0.
- Motion by Philip Stiemann to set board hourly wage to \$20.00/hour when working for the Town of Siren (Excluding Board duties). Second by Chris Tewalt. Motion carried 5-0.
