The Town of Siren held their monthly board meeting on December 12th, 2024, immediately following the Sanitary District meeting at the Siren Town Hall

Ordinance Review: John reported that some trees were cut from Town land over the summer. Inquired whether the Board would consider an ordinance establishing permit process for harvesting wood from Town owned property. No action taken.
