The Town of Siren held their monthly board meeting on August 13th, 2026, immediately following the Sanitary District meeting at the Siren Town Hall.

Chairman Wayne Wiberg called the meeting to order at 6:49PM.

Open Meeting Notices were verified.

The Village then has 60 days to pass an ordinance releasing the parcels. The Town would then have 60 days to accept it. State Statute 66.0227 covers the process.
