The Siren Sanitary District held their monthly board meeting on Thursday, January 8th, 2026, at the Siren Town Hall

Chairman Wayne Wiberg called the meeting to order at 6:30PM.

Motion by Diane Lund to approve the December 2026 meeting minutes. Second by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion by Philip Stiemann to approve paying the bills. Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 3-0.

Former Ruby's Pantry Building. In the Fall of 2025, Ruby's Pantry had a delinquent sewer balance in the amount of \$684.72. As is custom and as noted in the October 2025 minutes of the sanitary district meeting, a motion was made and approved to add the delinquent bills to the tax roll to be collected in 2026. During this same time the building was being sold to Mr. Andy Hursch. Since this liability was attached to the tax bill it is the responsibility of the property owner to pay the additional charge to Burnett County, and it would fall on Mr. Hursch to try and recoup those fees from Ruby's Pantry. To complicate matters, Ruby's did remit a payment in December so there is now a credit on the account however the tax liability remains.
