

SIREN TOWN BOARD MEETING
JULY 9, 2026

The Town of Siren held their monthly board meeting on July 9th, 2026, immediately following the Sanitary District meeting at the Siren Town Hall.

Chairman Wayne Wiberg called the meeting to order at 6:45PM.

Open Meeting Notices were verified.

Treasurers Report: (Attached) Motion by Philip Stiemann to approve Treasurers report. Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 3-0.

Clerk's Report:

- Motion by Diane Lund to approve June 2026 Board Meeting Minutes. Second by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried 3-0.
- Motion by Wayne Wiberg to approve paying the bills. Second by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried 3-0.

Public Input: Keith Mogul, candidate for Assembly District 75, attended the board meeting just to hear concerns of the board and other in attendance.

Land Use:

- Motion by Wayne Wiberg to approve the certified survey map (CSM) as presented by Doug Crane for the properties located at 7253 and 7241 North Shore Drive. Second by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried 3-0.
- Motion by Philip Stiemann to approve the installation of steps from road down to the lake shore at 24534 Lind Road as discussed by property owner, Scott Rehbein. Top step shall be below the grade of the road and a minimum of five feet from the edge of the road. Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 3-0.
- Motion by Wayne Wiberg to approve rezoning of parcel 36770 owned by JEAN LLC from R-3 to R-1 provided it meets the minimum 150 ft lot width and all other state and county regulations. Second by Philip Stiemann. Motion carried 3-0.
- Other land use: Andy Hursh explained his intentions to purchase property south of highway 70 west of the Village of Siren. Since some of this property is within the Town of Siren and some within the Village of Siren, he is exploring the possibility of moving the village portion into the Town in exchange for giving some of the Town land along the highway to the Village. Board members will need some time to investigate what is in the best interest of the Town.

The Burnett County Family Resource Center is planning to host a 5k race on Saturday, October 31 and seeking permission to install signage and hold the race along portions of South Shore Drive and Lind Road. Motion by Wayne Wiberg to approve request. Second by Diane Lund. Motion carried 3-0.

Roads & Equipment:

- a. Road Maintenance: Discussion on roads that will be crack and chip sealed in 2026. Some damage to Tewalt Road occurred over the 4th of July weekend when someone ran off the road. Damage appears to have been caused by the recovery of the vehicle. Mowing in progress.
