Land Use:

- The Village of Siren voted against separating the parcels as wished by Andy Hursh so no further action is needed from the Town. He is considering annexing some Town property located along Highway 70 into the Village.
- Next STR meeting is December 7th. Diane reported that some STR owners are opting out of the rental process as the income is not as much as they expected.
- Data Centers will fall under a new zoning category at the County. Unless the Town opts to have land zoned for this usage, any application for a data center would require a change in zoning and comprehensive plan....both of which could be denied by the Town or the County.

- a. Road Maintenance:
 - i. Mowing is done. Patching and shouldering in progress.
 - ii. Andy Hursh would like to clear brush in the ROW along Luverne Rd. This cannot be done by him for liability reasons.

 - iv. Tree harvesting is nearly done at Taylor Lake. Will need to look into building berms to keep vehicles out of the area.
